

Windows Mobile 5 & 6 with Co-Pilot and Oziexplorer

Immediate Actions:

The three following Immediate Actions solve most of the problems that may arise on the Windows based PDA's.

1. **Maps cannot be seen or displayed.** Most probably you have changed the SD Card and Windows in its wisdom has renamed the replaced SD card.

- a) take the SD card out of the PDA. Are you sure the slot is empty?
- b) Select Start -> Programs -> File Explorer
- c) Hi light image of PDA in top left corner under the Windows logo. The word Show should appear next to the logo and My Device below it.
- d) Click on My Device and the words SD Card or SD Card1 etc may appear (if this is the problem). But there is no SD card in the machine!
- e) Delete the reference to SD Cards by firmly pressing with the stylus on the words SD Card, waiting for the ring of dots to appear and then select delete.
- f) Close File Explorer, close Programs and replace the SD Card.
- g) Re run Co-Pilot or Oziexplorer and the maps should appear again

2. **Machine appears to be running slower than usual or it cannot find the GPS** after running the other mapping programme.

- a) Select Start and then Select Settings
- b) Select System Tab on bottom and then Memory icon
- c) Select Running Programs
- d) Oops. Did you know all those programs were running?
- e) Select Stop all
- f) Then OK
- g) Close Settings and start required program again

3. **Vulcan Pinch Grip.** When all else fails press the reset button on the base of the PDA with the Stylus and this restarts the machine in your selected Start up mode.
